Build, operate, and maintain a world-class network of transportation infrastructure to ensure that all San Diegans can safely and effectively get where they need to go.




## Transportation Department

### Who We Are:

### 500+ City employees responsible for:

- 3,000 miles of streets and alleyways (147 FTE)
- 4,500 miles of sidewalks (57 FTE)
- 1,100 miles of streets planned for utility undergrounding (22 FTE)
- 10,000 service requests each month (16 FTE)
- 60,000 street and park lights (30 FTE)
- 1,650 traffic signals (34 FTE)
- 50,000 street name signs (2 FTE)
- 250,000 trees along City streets (18 FTE)


